## RESOLUTION DECLARATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Emergency Management of Page County hereby found:

1. Due to the winter weather and possibility of an electrical grid shutdown, Page County is facing dangerous conditions;
2. Due to the possibility of the electrical grid shutdown and the road conditions, a condition of extreme peril of life and property necessitates the proclamation of the existence of an emergency;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED** that an emergency existed throughout said Jurisdiction; and

**IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED** that during the existence of said emergency; the powers, functions, and duties of the Emergency Management Organization of Jurisdiction were those prescribed by State Law and the Ordinances, Resolutions, and approved plans of Jurisdiction in order to mitigate the effects of said emergency.
