Policy and Structure for Tip Fees
Effective 1/16/2006
Revision 1 Effective 6/21/2006
Revision 2 Effective 5/15/2012

1. Page County residents are allowed to dispose of residential/household bagged trash and recycling at the county convenience sites or landfill free of charge. Non-residents, commercial customers, or materials that are not considered to be residential/household bagged trash are charged a “Tip Fee”. “Residential/household” is refuse that is typical from a household generated by private citizens from their home of residence. Scrap tires are NOT considered to be residential/household trash. Only bagged residential/household trash and recycling may be disposed of at the county convenience sites. All other materials require a scale weight and shall be disposed of at the Battle Creek Landfill.
2. A Tip fee of \$45.00 per ton shall be charged for bagged, non-construction debris or bulky materials that are not Page County “residential/household”.
3. A Tip Fee of \$60.00 per ton shall be charged for all rough materials that are bulky in nature such as mixed loads, loose items, construction debris, furniture, sludge and land clearing debris.
4. Segregated recyclables brought by Page County commercial customers shall not be assessed a Tip Fee and shall be accepted free of charge. Recyclables brought by Non Page County customers shall be charged a Tip Fee in accordance with items 2 & 3 listed above.
5. The Tip Fee for loads of segregated very light materials, such as foam, rubber products or styrofoam shall be based on volume rather than weight. This fee will be set at \$5.00 per cubic yard. Volume shall be computed on the outside dimensions of the container carrying these materials.
6. Whenever the scales are rendered inoperable, Tip Fees will be assessed on a per-load basis as follows:
 - a. Pickup truck, no racks, or smaller vehicle: \$10.00.
 - b. Pickup truck with racks, or single-axle trailer: \$20.00.
 - c. Single-axle dump truck, or tandem-axle trailer: \$45.00.
 - d. Stake body truck: \$65.00.
 - e. Tandem-axle dump truck; \$90.00.
 - f. Compactor type vehicle up to 10 cubic yard capacity: \$90.00.
 - g. Compactor type vehicle with capacity over 10 cubic yards up to 19 cubic yards: \$135.00.

- h. Truck with open top roll-off bin: \$225.00.
 - i. Tractor trailer with dump body: \$225.00.
 - j. Compactor type vehicle with capacity over 20 cubic yards up to 29 cubic yards: \$225.00.
 - k. Compactor type vehicle with capacity over 30 cubic yards: \$315.00.
7. Tires brought in for disposal by anyone, including citizens, shall be charged at the following rate schedule:
- a. Passenger/light truck tires: \$1.50 per tire
 - b. Rims/wheels: \$1.00 per rim
 - c. Truck tires: \$4.00 per tire
 - d. Tractor/oversize tires: \$2.00 per quarter section
 - e. Bulk or business tire rate: \$155/ton
